- New Floor and Paint: Ad Pro will be installing new floor February 14-18, in the Main room, Entry, Kitchen, Bathrooms, and Bathroom hall. Community Center will be closed during this time, and possibly the week prior to allow painting to be done. Reba talked with several other organizations that have this type of floor, they stated how easy it is to maintain. Dust mop and wet mop took care of clean-ups.
