

February 2016 Minutes

- Meeting started at 6:00 PM on 2/1.

Topics:

- Volleyball Court. Laura Redding reported that the town council will match \$3500 if the Park and Tree Board comes up with this amount. Sasha from WHS will work on fund raisers. It was noted that the GoFundMe site for the beach volleyball court had not yet received any donations. Rick Homkes asked if the top soil from the volleyball area would be kept on the site, and Laura Redding said that it would.
- Gene Parks. Laura Redding did a quick update on what the Gene Parks money could be used for. Since the fund is for quality of life for seniors and children, some could be used for volleyball.
- Community Center Park Seeding. Rick Homkes said that this project will have to be done this spring and volunteered to manage it. No one objected. Seed is in storage.
- Community Center Park Walking Trail. Laura Redding reported that the county will put in \$15K to the project. After some discussion the width of the trail was increased to 8' since that is what was suggested / requested at the Town Council meeting by Donnie Parvin. After some discussion, there was agreement to cut the loop around the Community Center Building in order to save money. Laura Redding will tell Matt Johnson so that a different plan can be developed and bid out.
- Indoor Garage Sale. The CC Building will be used for an indoor garage sale this weekend. Josh Welch is the lead on this per Laura Redding.
- CC Kitchen Certification. This is still being worked on by Josh Welch per Laura Redding.
- Time for Meetings. At Laura Redding's request, the time of the Park and Tree Board Meeting will be changed to the First Monday at 5:30.
- Brady Park. There was discussion about the fence around Brady Park and the broken airplane teeter tooter. Kyle Parvin will talk to the town guys about removing the airplane. The fence may not be fixable as the cross bars are bent.
- CC Playground. There was discussion about the playground needing to be ADA compliant because it is new construction. It was suggested that a shelter with bench near the playground was also needed.
- Western Senior Day. There was a long discussion of how projects would be picked and how students would be assigned. The problem of student monitoring was also discussed because of some issues last year.
- Budget. Erica Parvin volunteered to work with Laura Redding to develop a budget for the year that includes the CC.
- There were no additional comments from board members or guests.
