



June Regular Board Meeting Minutes June 2, 2020

- Meeting started at ~7:00 pm

Topics

- RTP Fundraising. Two bricks sold
- Eagle Scout Project. The sand volleyball court at CC Park was approved by the Town Council and will be completed this summer.
- Shelter/Playground in CC Park. Dave Kieser laid out plans for the shelter / pavilion. Very expensive. He also gave a list of possible grants. Moved by Homkes / seconded by Hyman to move forward with the project and apply for grant due 6/1/2021. Vote was 5-0.
- The replacement piece of equipment for Brady Park section of the playground will be installed June 6.
- Benches from bottle caps. Caps must be sorted, not for color, but to insure that they are the accepted type of caps and free of any dirt. They also must be weighed and put into bags of a certain amount of pounds. Because of school being closed, we could not sort the caps.
- Color run fundraiser for Benches at CC Park. Would like to partner with Russiaville Health Care along with the Western HS Environmental Club. Timeline is August or early September.
- Sound baffles for Community Center. This year or next. Janna will call Dave on this. Estimate was \$5,000.
- Budget. Short discussion of budget request for next year.
- Trails. Discussion of the two proposed resolutions to the council. These are the Establishment of the Around the Town Trail and the Support for the Cloverleaf Trail. Moved by Homkes, seconded by Hyman to approve these resolutions and submit them to the council. Vote was 5-0. Estimated cost of trail enhancements (benches, signage) is \$1,000.
- Discussion on new park board member to take the place of Ashley Wyrick. Jill will talk to people.
- Disc Golf. A nine hole course would cost approximately \$2,500. Could be done in 2020 or 2021. Jill will discuss with council.
- Park trees and mowing. More damage; need a barrier to protect trees like mulch or Round Up. Also need to trim trees. Any volunteers?
- Recreational Trail. Trail will have plywood across it for a few days as equipment is moved and the trail is sealed. Thus trail will be closed. Dates are projected to be June 8-10.
- Retention wall at pond. Needs reinforcement. Jill will bring to Council.
- Mulch for Town Park playground. Jill will ask Kaleb Hollingsworth for donation.
