- Donations from American Water: Rick showed four rock designs for the park signs estimate is \$2995.00 we will be \$495.00 short from the donation. Still working on other ideas
- Recycling bins and benches: Grant for the recycling bins was a "NO". We are still working on getting benches.
- Community Day Projects: Reba is going to work on getting to senior citizens signed up. Stain the train at the interurban station and the picnic tables. Mulch the park. Sweep the streets.
- Feed a Bee Grant: Plants will start coming in this week. Rick will keep them alive until it's time to plant them and then Master Gardeners will plant them.
- Russiaville Town Park: We still need an ADA entrance, it may be possible and save money to buy materials and build a ramp instead of buying a ramp. Jill is going to talk to Caleb at Hollingsworth Lumber to see if she can get some help with mulch for community day. The new slide that Jill got to replace the damaged slide in the park (at no cost) was damaged when we received it. Jill and the town guys both looked at it to see if there was anything they could do about it. Jill also called the company to let them know about it and they are trying to decide if it was damaged during shipping or before it left their warehouse.
- Rick brought to the board an issue where a property owner has put a fence up that is 6 inches over on park property in Western Heights and wants Mike Kanable to look into it Rick drafted a letter from the park board. Matt motioned that we send the letter and Reba seconded. Laura voiced some concern that it wasn't our business to be involved in.
