Council present for meeting were as follows

Jeff Lipinski opened the meeting.

Council asked Randy Vannatter about the tornado siren. Jeff Lipinski asked Megan Reel to check on a grant from the Community Foundation.

Randy Vannatter said he had looked into a new siren, he had also been apprised of a siren that we already have that is being stored at the wastewater plant. He stated he would like to see if the siren we had worked. If it does, we could get it painted and get a pole to put it on. This would save money for this year. Council agreed.

Council discussed Marshal's salary for 2019.

Council went over all appropriations and decided what they would need for 2019. The total was \$978,958.00.

Council would like to add an appropriation called Training-Marshal (101001233) for \$2,000.00.

Craig presented his budget for wastewater.

Don Parvin said Dave from Kieser Consulting had looked at the tree at 345 E. College St. and said it was dangerous and needs to be removed. Don Parvin made a motion to spend the \$900.00 to remove the tree, and to bill the owner of the property as they were not taking care of it like we asked them to. Cindy Aeschliman seconded. Rob Hewitt abstained. The motion carried with Don, Cindy, and Kyle voting for passage.
