- Sean Childers Eagle Scout Project/Interurban. Sean has completed the project to Jan Koloszar's satisfaction. She signed off on the project. She said she is satisfied that he did a good job.
- Foundation grant – It was reported that the Town Council approved for the Park Board to apply for the grant.
- Plant trees at Russiaville Town Park to be proactive in case the current Ash Trees do not make it.
- Western Heights Pond. There was a discussion as to whether we should be able to see the pond. Some people in the community had no idea there was a pond there since it is not visible from the road.
- Interurban. It was reported that Dave Keiser had said at the Town Council meeting that he was looking into a grant to finish the inside.
- Ideas for Community Center and RT. There were a few ideas discussed about possible future events to be held at the community center (prom, fun night, fish fry) and at the RT (pledges for walk-a-thon, night walk with luminaries and carolers at Christmas)
