

Town of Russiaville, Indiana
Special Meeting – to open bids
Town Hall (held in garage area in town hall)
April 13, 2020

Council Present – Jeff Lipinski, Don Parvin, Pat Reel, Myrna Claar, and Greg Landrum. There were 9 people present.

Jeff Lipinski opened the meeting for the bid opening for the sidewalk project on main street.

The bids were opened in the order and amounts that follow:
Calumet Civil Contractors – \$126,490.00 (bid Alt. - \$139,000.00)
DC Construction Services - \$78,834.35 (bid Alt. - \$86,184.35)
E&B Paving - \$121,635.00 (bid Alt. – \$134,985.00)
Heartland Excavating - \$101,156.00 (bid Alt. - \$114,941.00)

These bids will be taken under advisement and reviewed by Kieser Consulting. Don Parvin made a motion to close the bids. Pat Reel seconded, and the motion carried with Don, Pat, Myrna, and Greg voting for passage.

Don Parvin said he had evaluated the town's new employee, Paul Sattler, after his first 30 days. He feels that Paul is doing a good job and has caught on to the job very well. Don Parvin made a motion to give Paul Sattler a raise from \$13.00 per hour to \$14.00 per hour. This would be effective the next full pay week of April 18th-24th, as this pay week has already started. This would make the first check date be May 1st, as we withhold a week. Pat Reel seconded, and the motion carried with Don, Pat, Myrna, and Greg voting for passage.

Don Parvin said that Paul Sattler expressed that he would like to have the vision and dental portion only of the health insurance. Don Parvin made a motion to give Paul Sattler vision and dental insurance through our plan. Greg Landrum seconded, and the motion carried with Don, Greg, Pat, and Myrna voting for passage.

Don Parvin said there is a spot at the cemetery along the south side, where all the dirt had been dumped, that is along the town's easement. Don would like permission from the council to have the dirt spread out in this area, so that is all even through there. The council all agreed that would be fine to do.

Pat Reel asked if we would be having our regular meeting this next Monday. Jeff Lipinski said he was not sure yet, he was still having meetings about COVID-19 and would let everyone know very soon if we needed to cancel it.

Don Parvin made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Pat Reel seconded, and the meeting came to an end.
